SATs Revision

Pupils will have brought home with them some CGP revision books to support their learning ahead of SATs. **Please** ensure that pupils bring these books to school each day with them as they will be used in class as well as at home.

In the table below are details of key skills that pupils can focus on during the Easter holidays in each of the curriculum areas that they will be formally assessed in. I've also included page numbers, where applicable, for the text books that they are bringing home with them:

However, please feel free to allow your child to read other sections as well as the pages listed above if they want to. Remember that revision is helpful but (like the Easter eggs) don't overdo it! Have a rest, have fun and recharge your batteries as well.

Here are some things that you can do with your child over the Easter holidays to help prepare them for the forthcoming SATs that they will be taking in May.

Times tables.

The tests will require pupils to use their instant recall of multiplication and division skills. Particular times tables to focus on include the 7, 8, 9 and 12 times tables. Pupils can improve these skills by playing the **Hit the Button** game online and **Times Tables Rockstars**:
