

As of September, we will no longer be engaging with Rocksteady music lessons in school. We have now joined with **Rock It Music** to offer all our pupils the opportunity to engage in quality music education. Miss Scoines will be providing lessons to Year 1 through to Year 6, to support our music curriculum. This will be completely funded by the school, providing every child with the opportunity to learn various instruments, including keyboard, ukelele, and steel drums. They will also be able to perform in school concerts.
