


Year 3 Autumn Term 1 2024


English:

This term we will be exploring the text 'Tuesday' The children will be writing several pieces of work using descriptive language, similes and metaphors.




There will be more focus on presentation, handwriting and spellings. The children will practice the 3/4 statutory word list. These spellings will be sent home weekly and need to be practiced.

The children will also be exploring the text 'The First drawing' by Mordicai Gerstein in their guided reading lessons. This text is about the stone age and links to our history unit being taught in Autumn term.



Maths:

In maths the children will be learning more about place value as well as ordering and counting numbers up to 1000.

Throughout the term, we will be following the scheme 'Ten Ten'.



Geography: Climate Zones.

This half-term the children will be learning about different

climate zones. They will also be exploring different weather and be comparing

operations (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication).	This half term the children will be; identifying properties of charcoal, exploring contemporary artists, exploring different drawing exercises and be using a range of materials to create varied mark making.
Music: Keyboards with Rock it music. The children will be having music lessons every Monday with our new music teacher from Rock it music. The children will be learning how to play different songs on the keyboard.	Science: Animals and the human body. The children will be learning about different types of skeletons for animals as well as the human skeleton. They will also be exploring the different food groups and what types of food make up a balanced diet.
Computing : Online safety-the children will be learning about how to stay safe online throughout the year. They will also be learning about computing systems and networks in computing lessons this half-term.
