


Grateful and Generous



- To measure a perimeter on a grid
- To measure the perimeter of rectangle and rectilinear shapes
- To find missing lengths and calculate the perimeter of rectilinear shapes

History: Roman Britain

We will be learning:

- To know how the Roman Empire became so powerful
- To describe the different Roman beliefs and compare them to Ancient Greece
- To know who Julius Caesar was
- To understand why Boudicca led a revolt against the Romans
- To know how the Romans changed Britain

 To describe ecosystems and how they are affected by changes in the seasons




- To understand human impact on the environment through deforestation
