English:

Our focus text to begin this half term is 'The Proudest Blue: a Story of Hijab and Family.'

We will be looking at the features of a diary entry. We will practice writing in past tense, first person, using emotive language and using commas in a list. After exploring the characters' emotions, we will be writing our own diary entries about Aasiyah's first day at school wearing her hijab.

This text will also allow us to explore the experiences of people following a different religion.

RE:

Christmas

We will learn about:

- The annunciation and Mary's 'yes'
- Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem
- The Epiphany and the Wise Men's journey
- Mary and Joseph's escape to Egypt

Special Celebrations

We will learn about:

- Colours and symbols of seasons of the church
- Christmas, Lent and Easter in different countries
- Sacraments and how Jesus welcomes people
- Baptism and marriage ceremonies

Maths:

Money

We will learn:

- To count money in pounds and pence
- To choose notes and coins
- Different ways to make the same amount
- To compare amounts of money
- To calculate with money
- To make a pound
- To find change
- To solve two-step problems

History

Queens

We will learn:

- To understand the role of a Monarch
- To learn about the reign of Queen Elizabeth I
- To learn about the reign of Queen Victoria
- To know the similarities and differences between the two Queens
- To compare the similarities and differences between the two Queens

Music:

Our music sessions are taught by Rock It music.

The children will learn how to play different instruments, play and perform together.




Science: Living Things and their Habitats - Around the World

- Use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs

- Exploring brushwork by Van Gogh and Cezanne and record their own
- Exploring a still life scene
